FY 2017-18 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Phase I & II

PACIFICA, CA - The long-awaited FY 2017-18 Pavement Rehabilitation Projects will rehabilitate the pavement along Linda Mar Boulevard from Adobe Drive to Alicante Drive and Oceana Boulevard from Milagra Drive to Monterey Road (Phase I) and Linda Mar Boulevard from Alicante Drive to Oddstad Boulevard (Phase II).

Stage 1 of these projects will start Wednesday, December 26, 2018, and involves the construction of improvements to wheelchair access ramps at various intersections within the Phase I & II project limits.

Stage 2 includes pavement grinding, placing of asphalt overlay and pavement striping. This is scheduled to begin in January 2019 and is expected to last for several weeks. During this phase, Linda Mar Boulevard and Oceana Boulevard will remain passable, but delays are to be expected, so motorists are advised to take alternate routes. There will also be times when parking will be restricted within the project limit to allow construction crews full access to the roadway as well as for the safety of the public traffic passing through the work zone. Barricades with no parking notices will be placed on the street 72 hours prior to the start of work and remain until the work is complete.

Staff estimates that the entire project will be completed by March 29, 2019, weather permitting.

Funding for these projects is provided through a combination of funds from the One Bay Area Grant 2 (OBAG2), Senate Bill (SB) 1 and City Funds. Approved project budget for Phase I is \$1,083,308.88 of which \$671,000.00 will be reimbursed by OBAG 2, \$259,000.00 will be reimbursed by SB1 and \$153,308.88 from City Funds. Approved project budget for Phase II is \$765,098.20 from City Funds.
